WHAT IS TEF?

TEF (Test d'évaluation de Français) An international test designed to assess proficiency in French.

Recognized by: Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) for immigration and citizenship.

Ministry of Immigration in Quebec (MICC).

WHAT IS TCF?

TCF (Test de Connaissance du Français) Language certification from the French Ministry of Education.

Recognized worldwide for immigration, academics, or professional requirements.

DELF/DALF

DELF (Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue Française) and DALF (Diplôme Approfondi de Langue Française) are official qualifications awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French language.

These certificates are valid for life. DELF and DALF consist of six independent certificates that correspond to the levels of the Common **European Framework of Reference for Languages.**

1. Listening Comprehension:

This section assesses your ability to understand spoken French in various contexts by listening to conversations, news reports, and discussions, and answering questions based on your comprehension.

Contains 40 questions - 40 mins

2. Reading Comprehension:

MCQ Format in this segment, you'll have passages of varying complexity and your task is to comprehend the information and answer questions related to the texts.

Contains 40 questions - 60 mins

3. Oral Expression:

The Speaking section evaluates your ability to express yourself verbally in French. Tasks may include describing a picture, expressing opinions on a topic, and engaging in a simulated conversation with an examiner.

4. Written Expression:

This section examines your ability to convey information in written form. Tasks may include summarizing information, expressing opinions, and crafting formal letters or essays.
